ORDER DISMISSING PETITION FOR REVIEW

On March 4, 2003, UniSea, Inc., filed a petition for review of a permit determination regarding the above-referenced permit. The permit determination was issued by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Region X ("Region") on February 5, 2003.

On April 29, 2003, UniSea, Inc. filed a notice of withdrawal of its petition for review. UniSea avers that the Region has issued a revised permit determination that incorporates the changes sought by UniSea, Inc. In light of the Region's action, the petition for review is moot. See In re Arizona Municipal Storm Water NPDES Permits, 7 E.A.D. 646, 651-52 n.9 (EAB 1998) (issue moot where Region has withdrawn permit conditions of concern to petitioners and reissued the permits).

Upon consideration, the petition for review is dismissed with prejudice.
