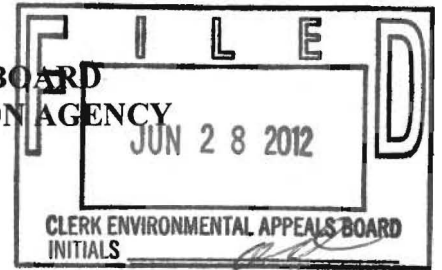

**ORDER STAYING PROCEEDINGS
