THIRD ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE RESPONSE

By motion filed on February 13, 2008, U.S. EPA Region 6 (the "Region") seeks an additional 20-day extension of time to file its response to the petition for review in the above-captioned matter. *See* Respondent's Third Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time to Submit a Response to Petitioner's Contentions (Jan. 23, 2008) ("Motion"). In support of this extension, the Motion states that, "the attorney at EPA national headquarters' Office of General Counsel working on EPA's response unexpectedly underwent surgery on February 8, 2008, and thus was not able to complete her work on the response. A new attorney * * * has been assigned to this matter and will need the additional time to fully understand the nature of Petitioner's concerns, to review the fifty-nine (59) page petition, to consider (as necessary) materials from the several hundred pages of exhibits of a highly technical nature, and to coordinate with EPA Region 6 and EPA headquarters Office of Water on the response." Motion at 1. The Motion states that the San Jacinto River Authority, the petitioner in this matter, does not oppose the extension request. *Id.* at 2.

For good cause shown, the Motion is granted. The Region's response to the petition for review, and to Petitioner's motion to supplement the administrative record, must now be filed with the Board no later than March 4, 2008.¹
