ORDER GRANTING BEELAND GROUP LLC'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

On May 23, 2008, the Environmental Appeals Board ("EAB" or "Board") established a briefing schedule in the above-captioned matter. *In re Beeland Group, LLC*, UIC Appeal No. 08-02 (EAB May 23, 2008) (Order Establishing Briefing Schedule) ("Order"). The Board ordered the permittee, Beeland Group, LLC, ("Beeland"), to file its brief responding to the merits of the petition filed by Star Township, Antrim County, and Friends of the Jordan River (together, "FJR Petitioners") by June 13, 2008. By motion filed June 2, 2008, Beeland Group, LLC, ("Beeland") requests a seven-day extension of time to file this response brief. Beeland's Motion for Extension of Time ("Motion"). The Motion states that the additional time is needed "because of the extensive technical nature of the response on the merits required by the Petition. * * * [The] extension will allow [Beeland] to provide an adequate response to [the] petition * * * ." *Id.* at 1. Beeland does not oppose the Motion. The permit issuer, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA"), Region 5 ("Region"), does not oppose the Motion. Beeland has not received a response from the FJR Petitioners regarding whether they oppose the Motion.

For good cause shown, the Motion is GRANTED. Beeland's brief responding to the merits of the FJR Petitioners' petition must now be filed with the Environmental Appeals Board no later than June 20, 2008.
