

ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO INTERVENE

On December 4, 2009, the permittee in the above-captioned matter, the City of Cambridge (the "City"), filed a motion requesting leave to intervene as a party respondent in this appeal.¹ The City represents that it will be substantially affected by the results of this proceeding, and explains that it has a definite and unique interest in the validity of the permit and the outcome of this matter. The City requests until December 22, 2009, to file a response addressing the issues raised in the petition.

¹ On November 2, 2009, Mr. Stephen H. Kaiser filed a petition seeking review of a permit decision issued by U.S. EPA Region 1. The permit decision allows the City of Cambridge to discharge wastewater from certain combined sewer overflows outfalls.

Upon consideration, the Environmental Appeals Board hereby grants the City's motion. The City shall file its response to the petition no later than Tuesday, December 22, 2009.
