## ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO DISMISS

On April 18, 2000 Morton International, Inc. ("Morton"), filed a petition seeking review of certain conditions of an Underground Injection Control permit issued by U.S. EPA Region V (the "Region") pursuant to the Safe Drinking Water Act, as amended, 42 U.S.C. §§ 300f - 300j-26. On three occasions (June 19, 2000, Oct. 6, 2000, and Dec. 5, 2000) the Board stayed consideration of the petition, at the parties' request, pending the outcome of settlement discussions.

On February 21, 2001, Morton filed an Unopposed Motion to Dismiss. The Motion states that the parties have reached a settlement agreement and requests that the Board issue an order dismissing the proceeding with prejudice. The Motion further states that the Region does not oppose entry of such an order.

Morton's Unopposed Motion to Dismiss is granted. The petition is hereby dismissed with prejudice in its entirety. So ordered.
