### ORDER GRANTING JOINT MOTION TO EXTEND STAY OF PROCEEDINGS

On September 25, 2009, Region 1 of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, in conjunction with petitioners Mirant Kendall, LLC, Conservation Law Foundation, and Charles River Watershed Association, filed another joint status report and motion to extend the stay of proceedings in the above-captioned matters. The parties report that they are "nearing settlement"; they anticipate completing their negotiations and agreeing to draft permit modification language by the week of November 16, 2009. The parties seek a further stay of two months to complete their settlement discussions.

This status report shall advise the Board on the progress of settlement discussions and whether it is appropriate to continue the stay, establish a revised briefing schedule, or take other appropriate action.
