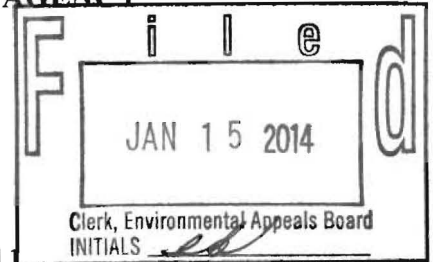


ORDER EXTENDING TIME FOR PERMITTEE TO FILE RESPONSE TO PETITION
