ORDER GRANTING JOINT MOTION TO EXTEND STAY OF PROCEEDINGS

On February 24, 2009, Region 1 of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, in conjunction with petitioners Mirant Kendall, LLC, Conservation Law Foundation, and Charles River Watershed Association, filed a joint status report and motion to extend the stay of proceedings in the above-captioned matters. The parties report that they have entered into "serious and substantive settlement discussions" regarding a potential permit modification and interim compliance order that potentially could lead to a resolution of the pending appeals without any further litigation. Joint Motion at 3-4. The parties seek a further stay of three months, explaining their view that the extra time is necessary for them to engage in further detailed and substantive settlement negotiations and attempt to reach a conceptual agreement on the "broad array of legal, policy, and technical issues." *Id.* at 4.

In the interest of judicial economy and for good cause shown, the Environmental Appeals Board hereby grants the motion and extends the stay of proceedings until **Friday**, **June 5**, **2009**. All parties shall file a status report (preferably jointly but separately if need be) with the Board no later than **Wednesday**, **May 27**, **2009**. This status report shall advise the Board on the progress of settlement discussions and whether it is appropriate to continue the stay, establish a revised briefing schedule, or take other appropriate action.
