ORDER GRANTING UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE RESPONSE

On January 28, 2010, Region 2 of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency filed a motion for an extension of time to file its response to an appeal of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit issued to Snapperfarm, Inc. At present, the Region's response is due to be filed with the Environmental Appeals Board on February 4, 2010. The Region seeks an extension until March 19, 2010, so that it can coordinate its response with the Agency's Office of General Counsel and so that key regional personnel, who will be absent in the next few weeks, will be available. The Region reports that consultants for the petitioner/permittee Snapperfarm, Inc., consent to the granting of this motion.

For good cause shown, the motion is hereby GRANTED. The Region must file its response to the petition for review on or before Friday, March 19, 2010.
