ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR STAY OF PROCEEDINGS

On December 4, 2006, Region I of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency filed a motion to stay the proceedings in the above-captioned matter. At present, Region I's response to the petition for review is due to be filed with the Environmental Appeals Board on Tuesday, December 19, 2006. In its motion, the Region reports that it and the Town of Marion, the petitioner and permittee in this case, believe that the issues raised in the Town's petition may be resolved through settlement discussions, and thus they have agreed to pursue such discussions. The Region therefore requests that its current December 19th filing deadline be rescinded and these proceedings be stayed for sixty days, by which date the Region volunteers to submit a status report on the progress of the settlement discussions, including recommendations on whether it would be appropriate to continue the stay, dismiss the petition, or establish a new briefing schedule for the Region's response to the petition. Region I notes that the Town of Marion assents to this motion.

For good cause shown, the motion is hereby **GRANTED**. Region I's December 19, 2006 filing deadline is rescinded, and the Region is directed to provide the Board with a report, on or

before Monday, February 19, 2007, describing the status of settlement negotiations in this case and suggesting a future course of action.
