

#### ORDER GRANTING THIRD JOINT MOTION

#### TO STAY THE PETITION

On November 30, 2006, the parties in the above-captioned matter, U.S. EPA Region IV (the "Region") and South Carolina Electric & Gas, filed a third joint motion requesting an additional 60-day stay of the proceedings in this case. On September 29, 2006, the Environmental Appeals Board ("Board") issued an order granting the parties' second request to stay the proceedings and extend the Region's deadline to file its response to the petition until November 30, 2006. In support of their second request, the parties explained that they negotiated a proposed modification to Permit No. SC00457752 (the permit object of this appeal), which would resolve the issues raised in the petition. The parties

further explained that additional time was necessary for the Region

to prepare and publish a Notice of Permit Modification and receive

public comments. The parties now explain that they have continued

working on the issues associated with the challenges to the permit

and that the Region is now in the process of drafting a permit

modification, which will be submitted to South Carolina for

Section 401 certification. The parties explain that the additional

time is necessary to finish drafting the permit modification, seek

state certification, and complete the modification process.

For good cause shown, the Board hereby grants the parties'

request to stay the proceedings until January 29, 2006. If the

parties do not reach resolution of the matters raised in the

petition by such date, the Region must then file a response to the

petition no later than January 29, 2006.2
