

**ORDER GRANTING FOURTH MOTION
FOR CONTINUATION OF STAY**

On July 18, 2007, Region IV of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency filed a motion with the Environmental Appeals Board seeking a continuation of the stay in the above-captioned proceedings until July 27, 2007. Region IV had originally attempted to file this motion with the Board via Federal Express on June 30, 2007, but the package containing the motion was held at a local Federal Express facility in Washington, D.C., for over two weeks, at which point it was successfully delivered to the Board. According to the motion's certificate of service, Region IV served counsel for petitioner Easley Combined Utilities via "electronic copy," although the exact date of service is unclear.

At this juncture, and having received no opposition from petitioner, we hereby **GRANT** the motion. The Region is now required to file its response to Easley's pending petition for review on or before **Friday, July 27, 2007**.
