In compliance with a February 28, 2024, order issued by the Environmental Appeals Board, the Region is serving notice of the Region's decision to issue UIC Permit No. PAS2D702BALL. Any party or other person who wishes to appeal the Region's decision may do so in accordance with the procedures at 40 C.F.R. § 124.19, which this notice summarizes below. Please do not refer to the appeals procedures set out in the attached Response to Comments on pages 40 to 42.

The provisions governing procedures for the appeal of an EPA UIC permit are specified at 40 C.F.R. § 124.19. Any person who filed comments on the draft permit or participated in one of the public hearings on the draft permit, can appeal the final permit by filing a written petition for review with the Clerk of the EPA Environmental Appeals Board (EAB). Additionally, any person who did not file comments or participated in a public hearing may petition for review of any permit conditions, but only to the extent that those conditions reflect changes from the draft permit.

A petition for review must be filed with the EAB Clerk within thirty (30) days after the Regional Administrator serves notice of the issuance of the permit. This means that the EAB must receive the petition within 30 days of the service of this notice. All parties and
