





Figure 1.0 Map Showing Area of Potential Effect (APE) for the Proposed Dewey-Burdock ISR Project





Figure 1.0 Map Showing Area of Potential Effect (APE) for the Proposed Dewey-Burdock ISR Project





Figure 1.0 Map Showing Area of Potential Effect (APE) for the Proposed Dewey-Burdock ISR Project





Figure 1.0 Map Showing Area of Potential Effect (APE) for the Proposed Dewey-Burdock ISR Project





Figure 1.0 Map Showing Area of Potential Effect (APE) for the Proposed Dewey-Burdock ISR Project
