Dear Mr. Ussery and UIC Class VI staff,

The Cheek Texas Community Association intends to submit a Petition for Review of the grant of the permits below to the Environmental Appeals Board. Due to the current

government shut down, and in order to provide both parties additional time to submit the petition for review, Region 6's response and the administrative record, the Cheek Texas Community Association will first submit a Motion for Extension of Time for an additional 60 days for the Petition for Review.

Based on the date below, the current Petition for Review would be due Monday, November 17, 2025. By seeking an additional 60 days, the petition for review would be due January 17, 2026, with EPA's response likely due February 17, 2026.
