In accordance with the Clean Air Act (CAA), as amended (42 U.S.C 7401 et seq.), the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Region 9 (EPA) has reviewed your application for a CAA Tribal Minor New Source Review permit authorizing the construction and operation of a Refined Coal Treatment System at the Navajo Generating Station.

Your signed permit and our notice announcing EPA's final permit decision is enclosed. Your permit becomes effective 30 days after the service of notice of this final permit decision, unless a petition for appeal is properly and timely filed with EPA's Environmental Appeals Board (EAB). In the event a petition for review is filed, construction of the Navajo Generating Station RCTS Project cannot begin under this permit until resolution of the EAB petition(s).
