In a letter dated October 3, 2019, you requested that the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's Office of Inspector General review why the EPA initially expressed support for the September 11, 2019 permit issued to San Francisco's Oceanside treatment plant and then later changed its position due to alleged water quality violations by the State of California.
