(Windfall). Comments raised during the public comment period ending December 31, 2012, raised a substantial question related to seismicity concerns about the proposed well. Pursuant to 40 C.F.R. 124.14(b), the Region is reopening the public comment period on this draft permit. The Region requests public comment on its proposed findings that the well as permitted is unlikely to pose a risk of induced seismicity and as to why earthquakes do not pose a risk to the construction and operation of the injection well.
