

ORDER EXTENDING STAY

By order dated September 29, 2005, the Board, at the request of U.S. EPA Region I (the "Region") and the City of Newburyport (the "City"), stayed consideration of the petition for review filed by the City in this matter (NPDES Appeal No. 04-05) until November 30, 2005. The Board granted this stay based on the representations of the Region and the City that they had reached a settlement agreement but were unable to finalize the agreement until they knew the outcome of a second petition for review filed by the Island Futures Group ("IFG") (designated as NPDES Appeal No. 04-06).

Because the Board has not yet reached a decision on IFG's petition for review, the Board has decided to extend the stay of the City's petition until December 30, 2005.
