**INTERVENOR EXXONMOBIL CHEMICAL COMPANY’S  
NOTICE OF SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION**

In its January 16, 2014 Motion for Expedited Review, Intervenor ExxonMobil Chemical Company (“ExxonMobil”) indicated that it expected to receive its state permit for the proposed Baytown facility ethylene production unit (“EPU”) by February 2014, leaving the federal Prevention of Significant Deterioration (“PSD”) permit as the last impediment to commencing construction and alleviating the ongoing harms recited in support of its motion. *Id.* ¶ 6. The purpose of this Notice is to notify the Board that the Commissioners of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (“TCEQ”) met on February 12, 2014 to consider the state permit and entered an order on February 18, 2014 approving ExxonMobil’s state permit effective immediately.

As a consequence of the TCEQ Commissioners’ action, resolution of the federal PSD permit appeal is the final outstanding issue. As the Board is aware, the one-year statutory deadline for EPA to take final action on the PSD permit application passed on December 10, 2013. Specific and monetary harms to individuals, the local community, and the company related to the ongoing delay were detailed previously in ExxonMobil’s Motion for Expedited Review and remain fully applicable. ExxonMobil is prepared to take all steps necessary to

commence construction of the EPU as soon as its federal PSD permit is final. ExxonMobil thus respectfully requests that the Board grant its Motion for Expedited Review.
