I am concerned about my drinking water. I have two working wells and one with a pump stuck. We all depend on private water wells.

There is a gas well close to my property, on Atkinson's. Back in the 70's and 80's whenever they (gas company) would blow that well, I would have a problem with water pressure. I used to mark the days on my calendar.

Another concern about having an injection well close to homes is losing the value of our properties and the risk to our health. Who would compensate for those problems?

I understand there are inaccuracies of the gas wells in the "EPA Response Summary". The permits should be denied because of this.

I would like a monitoring of all the gas wells to protect our water supplies if permit is approved.

The permit should be denied based on all the facts. Please consider our appeal.
