

MOTION FOR STAY

The City of Twin Falls, Idaho (the City) files this Motion to Stay for the reason that the City and the EPA have reached an informal agreement resolving all the issues presented in the City's two Petitions for Review, contingent upon the approval and issuance of a new section to the TMDL which, if approved and issued, will permit the City to remove TSS from non-point sources, to be credited to the City's WWTP point source, and subsequent reopening of the NPDES permit to make the necessary change. The City has agreed to dismiss both of its Petitions upon completion of this process, which is expected to take approximately six months. Counsel for the EPA has been contacted and does not oppose the requested stay.
