SECOND JOINT STATUS REPORT AND MOTION TO EXTEND ABEYANCE

Permittee Harvest Four Corners, LLC ("Harvest") and Region 6 of the United States
Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA") (the "Parties"), by and through their undersigned
attorneys, jointly submit this Status Report and respectfully request that the abeyance of Harvest's
CAA Appeal No. 24-09 be extended.

In support of this Motion, the Parties state the following:

- On November 15, 2024, the Board issued the Order Granting Joint Motion for Abeyance
 and Cancelling Oral Argument. The Order requested that the Parties file a Joint Status
 Report by February 13, 2025, notifying the Board of the status of the settlement discussions
 and including the Parties' proposal for further proceedings in this matter.
- 2. On February 13, 2025, the Parties filed a Joint Status Report and Motion to Extend the Abeyance, notifying the Board that the Parties had met to discuss the issues and concerns raised in the petition for the Part 71 permit, but noting that additional time was needed to negotiate a resolution of this matter.
- 3. On February 18, 2025, the Board issued an Order Granting Joint Motion to Extend

Abeyance. The Order requested that the Parties file a Joint Status Report by May 19, 2025,

notifying the Board of the status of the settlement discussions and to include in the Joint

Status Report proposed dates for oral argument if the parties have not reached a resolution

of the matter by that time.

4. Since the Order, the Parties have met on multiple occasions to discuss a resolution of the

matter. The Parties can now report that EPA has agreed to revise the Title V Permit to

remove the contested provisions and will utilize its authority under 40 C.F.R. § 71.7(f) to

reopen and revise the permit.

5. EPA is currently working to prepare a draft permit and will need additional time to reopen

and revise the permit.

6. The Parties respectfully request that the Board grant an additional 90-day extension of the

abeyance to afford EPA time to carry out this process. An extension of the abeyance will

also conserve the resources of both the Parties and the Board.

7. The Parties agree to provide a status update to the EAB within 90 days after an order

extending the abeyance is issued.

WHEREFORE, the Parties respectfully request the EAB grant this Motion and extend the

abeyance in this case.
