By letter dated December 7, 2011, the parties in the above-captioned matter—the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency — Region 2 ("EPA"), and Bacardi Corporation ("Bacardi"), (collectively, the "Parties")—notified the Environmental Appeals Board ("Board") that the Parties agreed to participate in the Board's Alternative Dispute Resolution ("ADR") pilot program.
