CONSENT AGREEMENT

- 1. Pursuant to the Consolidated Rules of Practice Governing the Administrative Assessment of Civil Penalties, Issuance of Compliance or Corrective Action Orders, and the Revocation, Termination or Suspension of Permits (Consolidated Rules of Practice or Part 22), specifically Subpart I, published at 64 Fed. Reg. 40138 (July 23, 1999) and the delegated authority of the Administrator of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA or Complainant) under Part C of the Safe Drinking Water Act (SDWA or the Act), 42 U.S.C. 1421, et seq., the EPA, as Complainant, hereby enters into the following Consent Agreement and Final Order (CA/FO) with Gene A. Wilson (Respondent).
- 2. Section 1450 of the SDWA authorizes the Administrator to prescribe such regulations as are necessary or appropriate to carry out her functions under the SDWA. These regulations are found at 40 CFR Parts 124, 144, 146, 147 and 148, and set forth requirements for the Underground Injection Control (UIC) program promulgated under Part C of the SDWA, 42 U.S.C. 300h, et seq.
- 3. Injection well owners and operators are required to comply with the UIC program requirements. The UIC program for the Commonwealth of Kentucky, including all Indian lands, is administered by EPA. See 40 CFR 147.901(a).

FINDINGS OF FACT

The parties hereby stipulate and find as follows:

4. Respondent is an individual and a "person" as that term is defined in Section

1401 (12) of the SDWA, 42 U.S.C. Section 300f(12) and 40 CFR 144.3.

5. Respondent owned the following injection well (subject well):

EPA ID No. EPA Permit No. Lease & Well No. Status
KYS1270250 KY10376 Gene A. Wilson #1 Plugged

- 6. The subject well, located in Lawrence County, Kentucky, constituted a "facility" as that term is defined in 40 CFR 144.3, and was authorized under a UIC permit issued on January 12, 1990.
- 7. Respondent properly plugged and abandoned the subject well on June 10, 2005.
- 8. EPA filed a Complaint against Respondent on May 15, 2006, alleging Respondent to be in violation of the SDWA, the UIC regulations and his permit for failing to demonstrate the mechanical integrity of and submit annual monitoring reports for the subject well.
- 9. Respondent filed an Answer on June 15, 2006, denying the allegations and requesting a hearing.
- 10. The Regional Judicial Officer (RJO) held a hearing on this matter in September 2007, and issued an Initial Decision on August 21, 2008.
- 11. Respondent appealed the Initial Decision to the Environmental Appeals Board (EAB) in January 2009 and both parties submitted briefs to the EAB. The EAB issued an Order directing EPA to submit a supplemental brief. EPA then contacted Respondent and the parties resolved to settle this matter for no penalty without further litigation.
- 12. The EAB held a conference call with the parties on September 1, 2009 and instructed the parties regarding the proper procedure for terminating the litigation. Specifically, EPA was directed to file with the Regional Judicial Officer a settlement agreement signed by both parties. After the settlement agreement IS signed and issued by the RJO, a copy is to be sent to the EAB accompanied by a Motion to Dismiss the Appeal.
- 13. This Consent Agreement and Final Order (CA/FO) constitutes the settlement agreement referred to in paragraph 12 above.
- 14. Complainant and Respondent have conferred for the purpose of settlement. EPA and Respondent waive any right to a hearing on this CA/FO and waive any right to further appeal this matter, and consent to the issuance of the final order without further adjudication. This CA/FO will conclude this matter before the RJO.

PENALTY

Based upon the foregoing Findings of Fact, the parties hereby agree and consent to entry of the following Order:

- 15. Respondent shall pay a civil penalty of zero dollars (\$0).
- 16. The well was never completed for injecting brine water and was never placed in service. The well was plugged on June 10, 2005

22. The Parties agree that, following issuance of this CA/FO by the RJO, a copy will be provided to the EAB as an attachment to a Joint Motion to Dismiss the Appeal.
