NOTICE OF APPEAL

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Respondent/Appellant, Environmental Protection Services, Inc. (EPS), by its undersigned counsel, submits this Notice of Appeal ("Notice") from an Initial Decision, In the Matter of Environmental Protection Services, Inc. (Docket No. TSCA-03-2001-0331), dated March 7, 2006, and served upon undersigned counsel on March 13 and 17, 2006.

In accordance with 40 C.F.R. § 22.30, Appellant's Notice sets forth below the following information:

1. Summary of the Order - Appellant appeals from an Initial Decision, issued by the Honorable Carl C. Charneski, on March 7, 2006, In the Matter of Environmental Protection Services, Inc., Docket No. TSCA-03-2001-0331. The Initial Order erroneously held that Appellant had violated the Toxics Substance Control Act and the terms of EPS's TSCA storage approval. These counts included the following: Count I in which EPA erroneously alleged (as a matter of law and/or fact) that EPS had stored waste PCB transformers in excess of the maximum storage capacity provided in EPS's TSCA PCB Commercial Storage Approval on two separate occasions for which a civil penalty of \$37,400 was assessed; Count II in which EPA erroneously alleged (as a matter of law and/or fact) that EPS had stored waste PCB commercial Storage Approval on two separate occasions for which a civil penalty of \$37,400 was assessed; Count II in which EPA erroneously alleged (as a matter of law and/or fact) that EPS had stored waste PCB commercial Storage Approval on two separate occasions for which a civil penalty of \$37,400 was assessed; Count II in which EPA erroneously alleged (as a matter of law and/or fact) that EPS had stored waste PCB capacitors in excess of the maximum storage capacity set forth in its TSCA PCB Commercial Storage

Approval for which a penalty of \$27,500 was assessed; Count III in which EPA erroneously (as a matter of law and/or fact) alleged that EPS had violated certain time and temperature requirements set forth at 40 C.F.R. § 761.72(a)(3), which regulated the burning of "regulated material" in EPS's Scrap Metal Recovery Oven for which a penalty of \$86,900 was assessed. The Initial Order, further, erroneously found (as a matter of law and/or fact) that EPS had failed to prove its affirmative defense of selective prosecution. In summary, Appellant appeals all findings of the Initial Order, including but not limited to the Initial Order with regard to Count I, Count II, Count III, Appellant's affirmative defense of selective enforcement, and the calculation of civil penalties.

2. Brief in Support of Appeal - Pursuant to the Environmental Appeal Board's Order Granting Appellant's Motion for Extension of Time to File Appeal Brief, dated April 4, 2006, by the Honorable Scott C. Fulton, Appellant's Appeal Brief will be filed on or before May 12, 2006.
