## **MOTION TO DISMISS**

The Sierra Club hereby voluntarily withdraws its petition for review in this matter and respectfully requests that the Board enter an order dismissing Sierra Club's petition for review in this matter with prejudice. The Sierra Club has conferred with counsel for the State of Illinois and the City of Springfield and they have authorized Sierra Club to state that they do not oppose this motion.

The Sierra Club requests dismissal because the parties have reached an agreement that obviates the need for further litigation. Their agreement provides, inter alia, that the City of Springfield will purchase 120 megawatts of wind power, increase its funding for energy efficiency programs ten-fold, and close its existing Lakeside power plant. These commitments are expected to reduce overall emissions of all pollutants, including cut the City's carbon dioxide emissions associated with providing electricity to its residents by approximately 25 percent below 2005 levels.

For this reason, Sierra Club withdraws its petition and respectfully requests that the Board grant this motion to dismiss the Sierra Club's petition with prejudice.
