On May 11, 2010, the Environmental Appeals Board ("Board") issued an Order Rescheduling Oral Argument and Granting NACWA's Motion for Leave to File Amicus Curiae Reply Brief ("Order"), in the matter of *In Re: San Jacinto River Authority NPDES Permit No. TX0054186*, NPDES Appeal No. 09-09.
