## JOINT NOTICE THAT NO APPEALS WILL BE FILED

The United States Environmental Protection Agency, Office of Pesticide Programs ("OPP"), AMVAC Chemical Corporation ("AMVAC"), the Grower-Shipper Association of Central California; J&D Produce; Ratto Bros., Inc.; and Huntington Farms (the "Grower Petitioners") (collectively, the "Parties"), hereby notify the Environmental Appeals Board ("EAB") that none of the Parties intend to file exceptions to the May 16, 2023, Initial Decision and Order issued by the Administrative Law Judge in Docket No. FIFRA-HQ-2022-0002.

Consistent with the Parties' July 21, 2023, Joint Motion To Extend Time For Filing

Notice of Exceptions and Appeal Briefs (granted by the EAB on July 25, 2023), AMVAC and

OPP continued to negotiate a settlement in this matter and have, as of the time of this filing,

executed an Administrative Settlement Agreement that does not require the EAB or the Office of

Administrative Law Judges to retain jurisdiction or provide any form of oversight or approval.

The Administrative Settlement Agreement executed by AMVAC and OPP is – apart from the

lack of direct oversight by the EAB – broadly consistent with the settlement agreement that the

Parties asked the EAB to incorporate into a Final Order on June 16, 2023. Specifically, the

subsequently negotiated and executed Administrative Settlement Agreement clarifies the framework governing the timing and conditions under which OPP will reinstate AMVAC's Technical Chlorthal Dimethyl ("DCPA") registration (EPA Reg. No. 5481-495).<sup>2</sup>

Because a temporary suspension of AMVAC's Technical DCPA registration is a premise of the Administrative Settlement Agreement, AMVAC and OPP request that the EAB decline review of the Initial Decision and Order and enter a Final Decision and Order as soon as practicable.<sup>3</sup>
