On January 8, 2008, the Office of Inspector General for the United States Environmental Protection Agency issued an evaluation report entitled *Despite Progress*, *EPA Needs to Improve Oversight of Wastewater Upgrades in the Chesapeake Bay Watershed*. The number one recommendation made by the Inspector General and agreed to by the Administrator was:

We recommend that the EPA Region 3 Regional Administrator instruct staff to:

Review and comment on State-drafted NPDES permits for significant facilities to ensure that interim construction milestones are included in compliance schedules longer than 1 year to meet the Chesapeake Bay allocations. The milestones should include:

- design completion
- construction start
- construction completion
- compliance with permit limits
