ORDER SCHEDULING ORAL ARGUMENT

On October 25, 2018, Evoqua Water Technologies LLC (“Evoqua”) filed a petition for review with the Environmental Appeals Board (“Board”) seeking review of a permit issued under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act by the Environmental Protection Agency Region 9 (“Region”) to Evoqua and the Colorado River Indian Tribes (“Tribes”) as co-permittees. The permit authorizes Evoqua and the Tribes to treat, store, and dispose of hazardous waste at the carbon regeneration facility located at 2523 Mutahar Street, Parker, Arizona 85244.

The Region has requested oral argument. *See* Region’s Response to Evoqua’s Petition for Review at x. Upon review of the record and the parties’ submissions, the Board has determined that oral argument will assist the Board in its deliberations. *See* 40 C.F.R. § 124.19(h). Accordingly, oral argument will take place on **Tuesday, April 9, 2019**, beginning at **10:30 AM Eastern Daylight Time** in the U.S. EPA Administrative Courtroom (Room 1152), William Jefferson Clinton East Building, 1201 Constitution Avenue N.W., Washington, DC 20460.

The Board has allocated a total of sixty minutes for this oral argument, with argument to proceed as follows:


- Evoqua: 30 minutes (with the option to reserve up to 5 minutes for rebuttal);
- Region 9: 20 minutes;
- Tribes: 10 minutes.

Counsel, or other duly authorized representatives of the parties, may opt to present argument by videoconference. The Board directs each party to file a “Notice Regarding Oral Argument” by **March 19, 2019**, providing the name of the individual who will present argument on its behalf and indicating whether that individual will appear in person or request to appear by videoconference.¹
