relevant portions of the administrative record within 30 days after the filing of the petition." Therefore, the Region's response brief is currently due on May 27, 2015.

- 3. Star's challenge to its NPDES permit raises a number of issues involving the interaction between state water quality standards and NPDES permitting. These issues require close coordination with multiple offices at EPA Headquarters. In preparing its response to the Petition, Region 10 will need to consult and coordinate with appropriate personnel in the EPA Headquarters Office of General Counsel and Office of Water, in particular the sub-offices within the Office of Water that oversee national NPDES permitting and water quality standards policy.
- 4. On May 13, 2015, the undersigned EPA counsel contacted counsel for Star who has not indicated whether Star will oppose this Motion.
- 5. Therefore, to allow sufficient time for the needed coordination within EPA, the Region requests that the EAB grant an extension on the time to file a response brief to June 24, 2015.
