## MOTION BY PERMITEE TO PARTICIPATE

NOW COMES Boston and Maine Corporation (B&M), by and through its counsel and requests leave to participate in the above captioned matter so that B&M may adequately represent its interest by participating in the Environmental Appeals Board's consideration of the "Petition to the Environmental Appeals Board for Review of NPDES Draft Permit # MA 0000272" dated October 26, 2005, submitted by Connecticut River Watershed Council, Inc., Jamison E. Colburn (Petitioners).

B&M is the Permitee under NPDES permit No. MA 0000272 (Permit). The Permit was signed on September 23, 2005. The Permit authorizes discharge at the B&M East Deerfield Yard, 38 Railroad Yard Road, E. Deerfield, MA 01342.

As reasons for its motion to participate, B&M states that it has a material interest relating to the Petition, as B&M is the Permitee. B&M further states that a determination by the Environmental Appeals Board as to the Petition may as a practical matter impair B&M's interest in the Permit. Finally, B&M states that its interest is not adequately represented by the Petitioners or by the Environmental Protection Agency Region 1 (Region). Both Petitioners and the Region have interests divergent from that of the Pennitee, B&M. B&M requests leave to participate so that B&M may adequately represent its position with respect to the Pennit.

B&M requests that it be allowed to file a written response to the Petition for Review on or before February 3, 2005. Such a response period would allow B&M the same amount of time to reply to the Petition as the Region has been granted by the Environmental Appeals Board under the Order Granting Motion for Extension of Time to File Response filed on December 7, 2005 by the Clerk of the Environmental Appeals Board.

WHEREFORE, B&M respectfully requests that the Environmental Appeals Board grant B&M's motion to participate.
