

Responses to the Petitions on or before March 14, 2005. By Order dated February 23, 2005, the Board granted the Region's unopposed Motion to consolidate these appeals.

3. The Board has granted three unopposed motions by the Region to extend the time for the Region to file its response to the consolidated petitions. The present deadline for filing is March 16, 2006.

4. Since the issuance of the December 19, 2005 Order granting the extension of the Region's time to file until March 16, 2005, the parties have had several discussions regarding potential settlement of the petitions for appeal. EPA made a settlement proposal to which WASA responded with a counter proposal. In turn, FoE/SC has proffered a counter proposal to the proposal made by WASA. The parties are presently engaged in the process of determining whether agreement in principal can be reached. The Region therefore seeks a stay of an additional sixty (60) days in order to pursue the possibility of substantially narrowing, if not fully resolving the issues that will ultimately require resolution by the Board..

5. The Region has consulted with counsel for FoE/SC and counsel for WASA and neither Petitioner opposes the requested stay of proceedings.

For the foregoing reasons, the Region requests a stay of these proceedings until May 16,
2006.


