Dear Sir/Madam:

It has come to our attention that you were not notified of the issuance of the final National Pollutant Elimination System (NPDES) Permit for the Wayland, MA wastewater treatment plant (MA0039853), which was signed on September 30, 2008. Federal regulations at 40 CFR §124.15 require that EPA notify the applicant and each person who has submitted written comments or requested notice of the final permit decision, and further requires that the notice include reference to the procedures for appealing the permit.

Because you submitted written comments on the draft permit, you should have been promptly notified. We apologize for the delay and are hereby providing the required notice. We have attached copies of the final permit, the response to comment document and a document describing the procedures for appealing an NPDES permit. Please note that appeals of NPDES permits must be filed with the Environmental Appeals Board within 30 days of receipt of notice (40 CFR §124.19(a)).
