ORDER RESCHEDULING ORAL ARGUMENT FOR APRIL 1, 2020

The Environmental Appeals Board ("Board") scheduled oral argument in the above-captioned matter regarding a petition filed by the American Bottom Conservancy ("Conservancy") challenging a Title V permit issued by Region 5 of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency ("Region 5") to Veolia ES Technical Solutions, L.L.C. ("Veolia") for March 5, 2020. Order Scheduling Oral Argument 1 (Jan. 17, 2020).

On January 21, 2020, Veolia filed an unopposed motion seeking to reschedule the oral argument to a date on or after April 1, 2020, due to pre-planned international travel by its counsel. Unopposed Motion for Extension of Date for Oral Argument 1 (Jan. 21, 2020). Veolia states that rescheduling the oral argument would allow counsel to adequately prepare for and present argument before the Board. *Id.* at 1-2. Veolia also states that neither the Region nor the Conservancy opposes the motion and that the Region has represented that it has coordinated with the appropriate offices and that they do not oppose rescheduling the date for oral argument. *Id.* at 2.

Based upon Veolia's representations, the Board **GRANTS** the unopposed motion.

Accordingly, oral argument is now scheduled for **Wednesday**, **April 1**, **2020**, beginning at

10:30 AM Eastern Time in the Administrative Courtroom (Room 1152), U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, William Jefferson Clinton East Building, 1201 Constitution Avenue, NW, Washington, D.C. 20004. The allocation of time for the argument remains unchanged. *See* Order Scheduling Oral Argument at 1.

Counsel, or other duly authorized representatives of the parties, may opt to present argument by videoconference.¹ The Board directs each party to file a "Notice Regarding Oral Argument" by **March 2, 2020**, providing the name of the individual who will present argument on its behalf and indicating whether that individual will appear in person or request to appear by videoconference.²
