ORDER GRANTING FIFTH MOTION FOR STAY OF PROCEEDINGS

On April 6, 2006, Region I of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency filed a status report and motion to extend the stay of the proceedings in the above-captioned matter, which currently runs through April 10, 2006. In its motion, Region I reports that the parties have successfully concluded settlement discussions and resolved all issues raised in the pending petition for review.

The Region notes that the City of Brockton has agreed to conduct a water quality assessment and install ultraviolet disinfection technology at its wastewater treatment facility. The Region explains that this agreement will be memorialized in a consent decree that currently is being negotiated to resolve an ongoing enforcement proceeding. The parties are now waiting for the consent decree to be finally negotiated, lodged, and entered in federal district court, at which point they will jointly move to dismiss the pending appeal. The Region estimates that it will take 130 to 160 days (approximately) to achieve entry of the consent decree in federal court and asks that the pending permit appeal be stayed pending that entry.

For good cause shown, the Region's motion is hereby **GRANTED**. The parties are directed to provide the Board with a status report on or before **Friday**, August 18, 2006.
