JOINT STATUS REPORT

Region 1 of the United States Environmental Protection Agency ("Region") and the General Electric Company ("GE") respectfully submit this joint status report in accordance with the U.S. EPA Environmental Appeals Board's ("Board's") Order Extending Deadline to File Region's Response (November 25, 2008) ("Order").

BACKGROUND

The Region reissued NPDES Permit No. MA0003891 to GE on October 3, 2008. On November 3, 2008, GE timely filed a petition for review with the Board contesting certain conditions of the permit. By letter dated November 6, 2008, the Board directed the Region to prepare a response that addresses GE's contentions and whether GE has satisfied the requirements for obtaining review. Subsequently, the parties jointly moved the Board to extend the deadline for the Region to file its response to GE's petition in the above-captioned matter until April 23, 2009, to allow the parties to explore the viability of settlement. The Board granted the motion and ordered the parties to file a status report no later than March 23, 2009, to advise the Board whether to further extend the deadline, to establish a revised briefing schedule or to take other appropriate action. *See* Order at 1-2. Since receipt of the Board's Order, technical and legal representatives from the Region, GE and the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection have been engaged in ongoing settlement discussions, punctuated by two rounds of in-person negotiations in Springfield, Massachusetts, the latest occurring on March 18, 2009. These discussions have been productive. They have resulted in substantial progress toward a fuller understanding of the parties' respective positions and toward developing a possible framework to resolve the NPDES appeal. Without diminishing the complexity and sensitivity of the issues facing the parties, the Region and GE are optimistic that this dispute can be settled.

REQUESTED RELIEF AND GROUNDS FOR SUCH RELIEF

At this time, the parties request that the Board take no action with respect to the existing April 23, 2009, deadline, as the parties are moving forward to resolve this matter with dispatch. If an additional stay is required for the parties to fully conclude their negotiations, the parties shall request a short additional stay, or request other relief as appropriate.
