

ORDER EXTENDING TIME TO FILE RESPONSES

By Motion filed ¹ on July 7, 2005, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("IEPA") seeks an eighteen-day extension of time to file its response to the petition for review filed in the above-captioned matter by the American Bottom Conservancy, the American Lung Association of Metropolitan Chicago, the Clean Air Task Force, Health and Environmental Justice-St. Louis, the Lake County Conservation Alliance, the Sierra Club, and Valley Watch. See Motion for Extension of Time to File Response ("Motion") (July 7, 2005). In support of its Motion, IEPA points out that the petition raises twenty-one issues containing a total of sixty sub-issues, and that the administrative record consists of approximately 40,000 pages. IEPA further states that, although it has devoted additional resources to this matter, it will require additional time to prepare and finalize its response.

For good cause shown, the Motion is granted. IEPA's response must now be filed with the Board no later than July 29, 2005.

Prairie State Generating Company ("Prairie State"), the permittee in the above-captioned matter, has filed a motion requesting that the deadline for filing its response be consistent with the deadline for IEPA's response. *See* Prairie State Generating Company, LLC's Motion for Response Date Consistent with IEPA's Response Date (July 7, 2005) ("Prairie State's Motion"). Prairie State's Motion states that such a coordinated deadline will prevent piecemeal filings and will allow Prairie State to coordinate with IEPA so as to avoid the filing of duplicative exhibits. For good cause shown, Prairie State's Motion is granted.² Prairie State's response must now be filed with the Board no later than July 29, 2005.


