Attached is an Expedited Settlement Agreement (“ESA”) that will resolve a Clean Air Act (“CAA”) administrative penalty action that has been signed by both parties and is now being submitted to you for approval in accordance with 40 C.F.R. § 22.18(b). Pursuant to 40 C.F.R. §§ 22.13(b) and 22.18(b), this ESA both commences and concludes the matter referenced above. The ESA resolves alleged violations of Section 203(a)(3)(B) of the CAA, 42 U.S.C. § 7522(a)(3)(B), stemming from Respondent’s online sales of aftermarket defeat devices for motor vehicles. Respondent was based in Clinton, Massachusetts at the time of violation, but the sales were nation-wide.

The ESA requires payment of a \$5,697 penalty, due within 30 days of its filing. This penalty amount is authorized under *Expedited Settlement Agreement Pilot for Clean Air Act Vehicle and Engine Violations Tampering/Defeat Devices* and the statutory penalty factors of Section 205(c)(2) of the CAA, 42 U.S.C. § 7524(c)(2). The ESA includes a certification of compliance with Section 203(a)(3) of the CAA.

Once the Final Order has been signed, I will file the fully executed ESA with the Regional Hearing Clerk, thereby resolving this matter. The Parties’ consent to the use of digital signatures (as well as Respondent’s consent to electronic service of the ESA, once filed) is included in the ESA. This settlement does not have any public notice requirements.
