Re: Administrative Order on Consent – Docket No. CWA-03-2023-0011DN

Dear Mr. Hudson:

Attached is the executed Administrative Order on Consent (“AOC”) concerning violations of the Clean Water Act (“CWA”), as amended, 33 U.S.C. § 1251, *et seq.* The United States Environmental Protection Agency (“EPA”) is issuing this AOC to Chemalloy Company LLC (“Chemalloy”) under the authority of Section 309(a) of the Clean Water Act (“CWA” or “Act”), 33 U.S.C. § 1319(a), for alleged violations at Chemalloy’s facility at 1301 Conshohocken Road, Conshohocken, Pennsylvania. The AOC requires Chemalloy to submit certain documents to EPA and implement certain activities in order to meet the requirements of the NPDES General Permit for Discharges of Stormwater Associated with Industrial Activity General Permit, PAG-03, which Chemalloy was granted coverage under, NPDES Permit Number PAR200003, beginning September 1, 2017 (hereinafter, “General Permit”).

Specifically, the Order in the AOC requires Chemalloy to:

- (1) Annually submit, for a 24-month period after the effective date of the AOC, the annual reports required by the General Permit and the completed inspection forms Respondent utilizes to comply with the General Permit; and
- (2) Propose, for EPA review and approval, a Corrective Action Plan (“CAP”) which meets the requirements set forth in the AOC, and when implemented, will achieve certain milestones within the timeframes outlined in the AOC.

Please note that the effective date of this AOC is today, the date of your receipt of this document. Under the AOC, Chemalloy must submit the annual reports and completed inspection forms to EPA on May 1 of each year in the 24-month period and must submit the CAP to EPA within 60 days, in accordance with Paragraphs 72 through 79 of the AOC.
