EXPEDITED SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

This ESA is issued to: Industrial Chemicals, Inc.

for violating 40 CFR § 68.160, 40 CFR § 68.50, 40 CFR § 68.58 and Section 112(r)(7) of the Clean Air Act.

This Expedited Settlement Agreement (ESA) is being entered into by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Region 4, the Director of the Air, Pesticides and Toxics Management Division (Complainant), and by Industrial Chemicals, Inc. (Respondent), pursuant to Section 113(d) of the Clean Air Act (the "Act"), 42 U.S.C. § 7413(d), and pursuant to 40 CFR § 22.13(b).

ALLEGED VIOLATIONS

Based on a compliance monitoring inspection conducted at the Respondent's facility located at 1125 Roberts Industrial Drive, Birmingham, Alabama, on July 15, 2010, EPA alleges that the Respondent violated the Act's Chemical Accident Prevention Program when at the time of inspection, Respondent did not provide evidence that:

As part of its Risk Management Plan registration, it assigned the correct program level(s) to its covered process(es) as required by 40 CFR § 68.160(b)(7);

Its process hazard review identified and documented a review of the following as required by 40 CFR § 68.50(a)(1) & (2): the hazards associated with the process and regulated substances, and opportunities for equipment malfunctions or human errors that could cause an accidental release; and

It has, at least every three years, certified that it has evaluated its compliance with the provisions of 40 CFR Part 68 to verify that its accident prevention program procedures and practices are adequate and are being followed as required by 40 CFR § 68.58(a)

SETTLEMENT

In consideration of Respondent's size, its full compliance history, its good faith effort to comply, and other factors as justice may require, and upon consideration of the entire record the parties enter into the ESA in order to settle the violation cited above, for the total penalty amount of \$5440.

This settlement is subject to the following terms and conditions: the Respondent by signing below admits the jurisdictional allegations contained herein, neither admits nor denies the specific factual allegations contained herein, and consents to the assessment of the penalty as stated above; Respondent waives its rights to a hearing afforded by Section 113(d)(2)(A) of the Act, 42 U.S.C § 7413(d)(2)(A), and to contest the allegations contained in this ESA; and each party to this action shall bear its own costs and fees, if any.

Respondent certifies, subject to civil and criminal penalties for making a false submission to the United States Government, that the Respondent has corrected the alleged violation listed in this ESA. Respondent shall pay a civil penalty of \$5440. Please note that payment <u>should not</u> be made until after Respondent receives a copy of the <u>fully executed</u> ESA. Within fifteen (15) days of receiving a copy of the fully executed ESA, the Respondent shall send a cashier's check or certified check (payable to the "Treasurer, United States of America") in the amount of \$5440, in payment of the full penalty amount to one of the following addresses:
