Respondents.)	

Complainant, United States Environmental Protection Agency, Region 8 (EPA), and Respondents, Wendy Mealer and Dennis Stokebrand, hereby consent and agree as follows:

- 1. On September 29, 2010 Complainant issued a complaint alleging a violation of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA). 7 U.S.C. § 136. The complaint proposed a civil penalty for the violation alleged therein.
- 2. Respondents admit the jurisdictional allegations of the complaint and neither admit nor deny the specific factual allegations of the complaint.
- 3. Complainant and Respondents waive their rights to a hearing before any tribunal, to contest any issue of law or fact set forth in the complaint or this consent agreement.
- 4. This consent agreement, upon incorporation into a final order, applies to and is binding upon EPA and upon Respondents and Respondents' heirs, successors or assigns. Any transfer of assets or real or personal property, shall not alter Respondents' responsibilities under this agreement. This consent agreement contains all terms of the settlement agreed to by the parties.
- 5. Respondents consent and agree to pay a civil penalty in the amount of **two thousand dollars (\$2,000)** in the manner described below:
 - a. Payment is due within 30 calendar days from the date written on the final order, issued by the Regional Judicial Officer that adopts this consent agreement. If the due date falls on a weekend or legal federal holiday, the due date is the next business day. The date the payment is made is considered to be the date of the deposit ticket (standard form 215) issued by the U.S. Bank. Payments must be received by 11:00 a.m. Eastern Standard Time to be considered as received that day.
 - Respondents shall make this payment by remitting a cashier's or certified check, including the name and docket number of this case (Wendy Mealer

and Dennis Stokebrand; Docket No. FIFRA-08-2010-0017), for the specified amount, payable to "Treasurer, United States of America," to:

- c. In the event a payment is not received by the specified due date, interest on the remaining unpaid balance accrues from the date of the final order, not the due date, at a rate established by the Secretary of the Treasury pursuant to 31 U.S.C. § 3717, and will continue to accrue until payment in full is received. (i.e., on the 1st late day, 30 days of interest accrues). Respondents agree and consent that if Respondents fail to pay the penalty amount on the due date set forth above, any unpaid balance thereof, shall become due and owing by the Respondents. EPA, in its sole discretion, may waive all or part of such acceleration and or such interest payment.
- d. In addition, in the event that payment is not received by the due date specified in this consent agreement, a handling charge of fifteen dollars (\$15) shall be assessed on the 31st day from the date of the final order, and each subsequent thirty day period that the debt, or any portion thereof, remains unpaid. In addition, a six percent (6%) per annum penalty shall be assessed on any unpaid principal amount if payment is not received within 90 days of the due date (i.e., the 121st day from the date the final order is signed). Payments are first applied to handling charges, 6% penalty interest, late interest, and any balance is then applied to the outstanding principal amount.

- Respondents agree that the penalty shall never be claimed as a federal or other tax deduction or credit.
- 6. Nothing in this consent agreement shall relieve Respondents of the duty to comply with FIFRA and its implementing regulations.
- 7. Failure by Respondents to comply with any of the terms of this consent agreement shall constitute a breach of the consent agreement and may result in referral of the matter to the Department of Justice for enforcement of this agreement.
- 8. Nothing in this consent agreement shall be construed as a waiver by the EPA or any other federal entity of its authority to seek costs or any appropriate penalty associated with any collection action instituted as a result of Respondents' failure to perform pursuant to the terms of this consent agreement.
- 9. The parties agree to submit this consent agreement to the Regional Judicial Officer, with a request that it be incorporated into a final order.
- 10. Each party shall bear its own costs and attorney fees in connection with this matter.
- 11. This consent agreement, upon incorporation into a final order by the Regional Judicial Officer and full satisfaction by the parties, shall be a complete and full civil settlement of the specific violations alleged in the complaint.
