EXPEDITED SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

DOCKET NO: <u>CAA-04-2005-8013(b)</u>

This ESA is issued to:

Auburn Water Works Board James E. Estes Water Treatment Plant 214 N. Donahue Drive Auburn, Alabama 36830

for violating the following requirements of Section 112(r)(7) of the Clean Air Act: 40 C.F.R. §68.48(a); 40 C.F.R. § 68.50(a); 40 C.F.R. § 68.54(b); and 40 C.F.R. § 68.58(a).

This Expedited Settlement Agreement (ESA) is being entered into by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Region 4, the Director of the Air, Pesticides and Toxics Management Division (Complainant), and by the Auburn Water Works Board (Respondent), pursuant to Section 113(a)(3) and (d) of the Clean Air Act (the "Act"), 42 U.S.C. § 7413(a)(3) and (d), and by 40 C.F.R.§ 22.13(b). On August 13, 2003, EPA obtained the concurrence of the U.S. Department of Justice, pursuant to Section 113(d)(1) of the Act, 42 U.S.C. §7413(d)(1), to pursue this administrative enforcement action.

ALLEGED VIOLATIONS

On December 16, 2003, an authorized representative of the EPA conducted a compliance inspection of the Respondent's James E. Estes Water Treatment Plant facility located at 1385 Binford Drive, Auburn, Alabama, to determine compliance with the Risk Management Program (RMP) regulations promulgated at 40 C.F.R. § 68 under Section 112(r) of the Act. EPA found that the Respondent had violated regulations implementing Section 112(r) of the Act by failing to comply with the requirements of 40 C.F.R. § 68. The specific alleged violations cited below are relevant to the chlorine process (RMP Process 56571):

- 1. Failure to document the codes and standards used to design, build and operate the process as part of the process safety information (40 C.F.R. § 68.48(a)(4)).
- 2. Failure to identify safeguards used or needed to control process hazards or prevent equipment malfunctions or human errors as part of the process hazard review (40 C.F.R. § 68.50(a)(3)).

- 3. Failure to identify any steps used or needed to detect or monitor releases as part of the process hazard review (40 C.F.R. § 68.50(a)(4)).
- 4. Failure to provide refresher training to each employee at least every three years, to ensure that the employee understands and adheres to the current operating procedures of the process (40 C.F.R. § 68.54(b)).
- 5. Failure to certify that the owner or operator has evaluated compliance with the RMP prevention program provisions at least every three years to verify that the procedures and practices are adequate and are being followed (40 C.F.R. § 68.58(a)).

SETTLEMENT

In consideration of Respondent's size, its full compliance history, its good faith effort to comply, and other factors as justice may require, and upon consideration of the entire record the parties enter into the ESA in order to settle the violations cited above, for the total penalty amount of **\$600.00**.

This settlement is subject to the following terms and conditions: the Respondent by signing below admits the jurisdictional allegations contained herein, neither admits nor denies the specific factual allegations contained herein, and consents to the assessment of the penalty as stated above; respondent waives its rights to a hearing afforded by Section 113(d)(2)(A) of the Act, 42 U.S.C §7413(d)(2)(A), and to contest the allegations contained in this ESA; and each party to this action shall bear its own costs and fees, if any.

Respondent also certifies, subject to civil and criminal penalties for making a false submission to the United States Government, that the Respondent has corrected the violations and has sent a cashier's check or certified check (payable to the "Treasurer, United States of America") in the amount of **\$600.00** in payment of the full penalty amount to the following address:

The Respondent's name and the Docket Number of this ESA <u>must be included on</u> <u>the check</u>. The Docket Number is located at the top left corner of the first page of this ESA.

Upon Respondent's submission of the signed original ESA (including an attached copy of the settlement penalty check), EPA will take no further civil action against Respondent for the alleged violations of the Act referenced in this ESA. EPA does not waive any other enforcement action for any other violations of the Clean Air Act or any other statute.
