#### PRELIMINARY STATEMENT

This proceeding for the assessment of a civil penalty was initiated on September 28, 2006, pursuant to Section 14 of the of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), 7 U.S.C § 136 et seq, when Complainant issued a Complaint and Notice of Opportunity For Hearing ("Complaint") to Hirsch Feed and Farm Supply, Inc. (Respondent).

The parties subsequently entered negotiations in an attempt to settle the allegations contained in the Complaint; this Consent Agreement and Final Order is the result of such negotiations.

#### **CONSENT AGREEMENT**

- 1. For purposes of this proceeding only, Respondent admits the jurisdictional allegations of the Complaint. Respondent neither admits nor denies the specific factual allegations contained in the Complaint.
- 2. Respondent waives any right to a judicial or administrative hearing on any issue of fact or law set forth in the Complaint and its right to appeal the proposed Final Order accompanying this Consent Agreement.

- 3. Respondent and EPA agree to conciliate this matter without the necessity of a formal hearing and to bear their respective costs and attorneys' fees.
- 4. Respondent certifies by the signing of this Consent Agreement and Final Order that, to the best of Respondent's knowledge, Respondent is presently in compliance with all requirements of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), 7 U.S.C. § 166 et seq., and all implementing regulations. Respondent recognizes that it bears full responsibility to ensure that it remains in compliance with all applicable federal, state and local environmental statutes and regulations and applicable permits.
- 5. Respondent consents to the issuance of the Final Order hereinafter recited and consents to the payment of a civil penalty in the amount of Four Thousand One Hundred Sixty Dollars (\$4,160.00) to be paid within thirty (30) days of the effective date of the Final Order.
- 6. The effect of settlement described in Paragraph 5 above is conditional upon the accuracy of Respondent's representations to EPA as memorialized in Paragraph 4 above of this Consent Agreement. Respondent understands that the failure to pay any portion of the civil penalty assessed herein in accordance with the provisions of this Order may result in commencement of a civil action in Federal District Court to recover the total penalty, together with interest thereon at the applicable statutory rate.
- 7. Respondent agrees not to contest EPA's jurisdiction in this proceeding or any subsequent proceeding to enforce the terms of this Final Order.
- 8. The undersigned representative of Respondent certifies that he or she is fully authorized to enter the terms and conditions of this Consent Agreement and Final Order and to execute and legally bind Respondent to it.

9. The settlement pursuant to this Consent Agreement shall resolve Respondent's liability for Federal civil penalties for the violations and facts alleged in the Complaint.

#### **FINAL ORDER**

- 1. Respondent certifies that, upon information and belief, it is in compliance with FIFRA, 7 U.S.C. 136 et seq., and all regulations promulgated thereunder.
- 2. Respondent shall pay a mitigated civil penalty, in the amount of Four Thousand
  One Hundred Sixty Dollars (\$4,160.00) within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this Order.
  Payment made by Respondent shall be made by certified or cashier's check payable to the United
  States Treasury, and shall bear the docket number for this matter, and shall be mailed to:

4. Respondent understands that its failure to timely pay any portion of the civil penalty stated in Paragraph 2 above may result in the commencement of a civil action in Federal District Court to recover the full remaining balance, along with penalties and accumulated

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interest. In such case, interest shall accrue thereon at the rate determined by the Secretary of the Treasury on the unpaid balance until such civil penalty and any accrued interest are paid in full. A late payment handling charge of \$15 will be imposed for payments received 30 days after the due date, and an additional \$15 will be charged for each subsequent 30 day period. As provided by 31 U.S.C. § 3717(e)(2), a 6% per annum penalty (late charge) will be assessed on any amount not paid within 90 days of the due date.

- 5. This executed Consent Agreement and Final Order shall be filed with the Regional Hearing Clerk, U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, 901 N. 5<sup>th</sup> Street, Kansas City, Kansas, 66101.
- 6. Each party shall bear its own costs and attorney's fees in connection with this action.
