Dear Mr. Summers:

Enclosed is a Final Administrative Order (Order) issued to you for violation of the Safe Drinking Water Act (SDWA). The violation was identified based on our review of files that we maintain on the referenced well. The violation was for maintaining Well No. 5 in a manner which could allow contaminants to flow through the well bore into underground sources of drinking water. The enclosed Order does not assess a monetary penalty; however, it does require compliance with SDWA requirements. You would be required to complete appropriate corrective actions on the well.

We issued a proposed Order on May 23, 2017 for review and comment by you and the public. We did not receive any comments on the proposed order from the public and you did not request a hearing. The proposed Order is hereby made final.

The SDWA provides that you, or any person who commented on the proposed order, may file an appeal of the final order with the United States District Court for the District of Columbia or the district in which the violations occurred. Such appeal must be filed within 30 days after the final order is issued. If you file an appeal, you must simultaneously send a copy of the appeal by certified mail to the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency and to the U. S. Attorney General.
