#### EXPEDITED SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

- The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA") alleges that ERS Technologies, Inc. ("Respondent"), owner or operator of the facility located at 13230 S.W. 132<sup>nd</sup> Avenue, Unit No. 24, Miami, Florida (the "Facility"), violated the hazardous waste generator requirements contained in Chapter 403 of the Florida Statutes (F.S.), F.S. §§ 403.702 *et seq.* [Subtitle C of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act ("RCRA"), 42 U.S.C. §§ 6921 *et seq.*], and the regulations promulgated pursuant thereto and set forth at Florida Administrative Code ("F.A.C.") Chapter 62-730 [Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations ("C.F.R."), Parts 260-270].
- 2. Pursuant to F.A.C. § 62-730.030(1) [40 C.F.R. § 261.41(a)], persons who export used, intact Cathode Ray Tubes ("CRTs") for reuse are required to send a one-time notification to the EPA prior to export. This notification must include a statement that the person plans to export used, intact CRTs for reuse, the assigned EPA ID number (if applicable) and the name and phone number of a contact person. A review of the EPA's records revealed that Respondent did not notify the EPA of its intent to export used, intact CRTs for reuse. Documentation received from Respondent indicates that Respondent exported various shipments of CRTs for reuse from October 10, 2009 to December 20, 2013.
- The EPA therefore alleges that Respondent violated F.A.C. § 62-730.030(1) [40 C.F.R. § 261.41(a)] by failing to notify the EPA of its intent to export used, intact CRTs for reuse prior to such export.
- 4. The EPA and Respondent agree that settlement of this matter for a penalty of \$1,000 is in the public interest.
- 5. The EPA is authorized to enter into this Expedited Settlement Agreement ("Agreement") pursuant to Section 3008 of RCRA, 42 U.S.C. § 6928, and 40 C.F.R. § 22.13(b).
- 6. In signing this Agreement, Respondent: (1) admits that Respondent is subject to F.A.C. Chapter 62-730; (2) admits that the EPA has jurisdiction over Respondent and Respondent's conduct as alleged herein; (3) neither admits nor denies the factual allegations contained herein; (4) consents to the assessment of this penalty; and (5) waives any right to contest the allegations contained herein.
- 7. By its signature below, Respondent certifies, subject to civil and criminal penalties for making a false submission to the United States government, that the alleged violation has been corrected.

- 8. Respondent agrees to the payment of a civil penalty of \$1,000, which shall be paid within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this Agreement, in accordance with the EPA Region 4 Penalty Collection Procedures provided to Respondent.
- 9. Payment of the civil penalty shall constitute full settlement of the civil claims alleged herein.
- 10. The EPA reserves all of its rights to take enforcement action for any other past, present, or future violations by Respondent of RCRA, any other federal statute or regulation, or this Agreement.
- 11. Upon signing and returning this Agreement to the EPA, Respondent waives the opportunity for a hearing or appeal pursuant to Section 3008(b) of RCRA, 42 U.S.C. § 6928(b).
- 12. Each party shall bear its own costs and fees, if any.
- 13. This Agreement is binding on the parties signing below, and, in accordance with 40 C.F.R. § 22.31(b), is effective upon filing of this Agreement and Final Order with the Regional Hearing Clerk.
