- B. The Project is located at Punta Soldado Road, Km. 2.4, Camino Fulladosa, Playa Sardinas II Ward, Culebra, Puerto Rico.
- C. The construction activities at the Project involved, among others, land disturbance, site preparation, utilities installation, and construction of residential units and recreational areas.
- D. Earth movement activities at the Project involved clearing, grading and excavation.

- E. On January 10, 2007, an EPA official performed an inspection of the Project (1st Inspection).
- F. The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) issued the Administrative Compliance Order CWA-02-2007-3073, dated September 11, 2007, against Respondents.
- G. On December 19, 2007, an EPA official performed a second inspection of the Project (2nd Inspection).
