This an Addendum to the Administrative Order (Order) issued on February 6, 2019, to Sloanes General Store. The purpose of this letter is to approve the Sloanes General Store, April 25, 2019 schedule extension request for coming into consistent compliance with the nitrate maximum contaminant level (MCL). The revised schedule is hereby incorporated into the Order per paragraph 7 (page 2) of the Order. Each milestone is an enforceable provision of the Order.


Remove Well #3 as a source for public consumption. The distribution will only be used for irrigation until further notice.	April 25, 2019 (reported as completed)
All public buildings that used to use Well #3 for their source of water have been transitioned to use only source water from Well #2	April 25, 2019 (reported as completed)
Nitrate monthly sampling for Well #1 and Well #2 until further notice (141.23(g))	Start in July 2019
Report monitoring results to the EPA within the first 10 days following the month in which the result is received. 40 C.F.R. § 141.31(a). Results shall be sent to the EPA at: R8DWU@epa.gov and carbballal-broome.christina@epa.gov	Within the first 10 days following the month in which the result is received, starting in August 2019.
Provide the EPA with quarterly progress reports	Reports are due September 30, 2019, December 30, 2019 and March 30, 2020.


Reassess and provide the EPA with updated information and potential onsite alternatives after a year.	April 25, 2020

The Order requires you to achieve and maintain compliance with the nitrate MCL. The Order also requires you to achieve and maintain compliance with the nitrate MCL to be specified at a later date in an updated schedule that shall be approved by the EPA. If Sloanes General Store has a reasonable basis to believe it may be unable to meet any deadline in the schedule, it shall notify the EPA well in advance of the scheduled deadline to request an extension. The EPA may, in its discretion, consider granting an extension.
